Traffic jam

IT MIGHT be standing room only at the **CQ** building this morning, where former mates **Con Liosatos** and **Con Scrinis** square off for control of **Traffic Technologies**.

Incumbent **C1** (Liosatos) and challenger **C2** (Scrinis) will battle for votes at an extraordinary meeting that begins at 10am at 123 Queen Street.

Private equity group **Equity Partners** has not converted its preference shares into voting stock, and it seems C1 has the numbers to see off C2. Chairman **Ray Horsburgh** will keep an eye on the meeting, while former transport minister **Alan Brown**, a director of Traffic Technologies, has a ringside seat.
