The Traffic Group's road signage division Allpack Signs has just completed the first service change for the prestigious South Australian DTEI's , Public Transport Division contract secured in August of this year.

This change encompassed the re routing of the majority of the metropolitan bus services and the changeover of more than 6800 time tables. Traditionally service changes of this magnitude have been planned and executed over 3 months.

Commuter disruptions have been negligible with high levels of satisfaction being reported in the media following the change over undertaken on the 27th and 28th of September.
