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Nasty dose of road rage for rival Cons

YOUTUBE is an unusual place to launch a company float but The Traffic Group is no ordinary company.

Formed by Con Scrinis, The Traffic Group is his attempt to finish the job he started when he led listed company Traffic Technologies, formed with long-time partner Con Liosatos to consolidate the splintered world of traffic lights, signs and lane markers.

The first dream came to an end when the two Cons who were joint managing directors failed to see eye to eye and the board ejected Con S.

Now the passionate traffic consolidator is back seeking \$5 million for the float of his three main businesses — Russell Signs, Allpack Signs and Cleansweep — in the listing shell of Western Kingfish.

Yesterday Con S said he had big plans for The Traffic Group and was lining up further acquisitions in the traffic signs area which he could use to bulk up market share and margins.

The intriguing bit is that at the same time, Con S is waging a proxy war with Traffic Technologies and trying to replace three board members at next month's AGM including his estranged mate Con L.

Both claim to have assembled more than 30 per cent of votes for the battle.
